

PRODUCTION INDUSTRY INCENTIVES

Nevada has:

- Free locations and scouting assistance
- Free photo base of thousands of images
- Free online directory and electronic info
- Free hardcover Nevada Production Directory
- Free intergovernmental liaison between state/county/cities
- Free photo guides to Las Vegas, Reno/Tahoe, Roads and Nevada's Countryside regions
- Abatement of room tax after 30 days
- Abundant, affordable below-the-line accommodations
- Extraordinary above-the-line options, comforts & luxuries (world class spas, hotels, dining, shopping, entertainment)
- Strong local crew base
- Superior telecommunications and other electronic/communications infrastructure
- Extensive transportation resources (Las Vegas has more than 50 flights a day between Los Angeles and Burbank)
- 320 days of sunshine (Las Vegas average)
- Unique locations: The Strip, Hoover Dam, Fremont Street Experience, Valley of Fire, Red Rock Canyon, Lake Tahoe, Downtown Reno, Lamoille Canyon, Ely's Steam Train, Ruby Mountains, Pyramid Lake, Reno Riverwalk, the Colorado River at Laughlin, Dry Lake Beds, West Wendover.

Doing Business in Nevada! Incentives as LLC:

- No Corporate Income Tax
- No Personal Income Tax
- No Unitary Tax
- No Inventory Tax
- Low Property Taxes
- Industrial Revenue Bonds
- Customized Industrial Training: This program provides job assistance to new businesses. The funds allow a company to quickly train workers in the specialized skills the company requires.
- Sales Tax Deferral
- Community Development Block Grants
- Business Assessment Tax Abatement

- Sales For Resale Are Exempt
- Sales for resale (wholesale) are exempt from sales & use taxes.
- Sales & Use Tax Deferment
- New and expanding businesses can defer sales and use taxes without interest for up to 5 years on certain capital goods purchased that are consistent with Nevada's plan for industrial development.
- International Trade Program: This program offers assistance to businesses to begin or expand exporting to international markets. (this may be worth investigating as it pertains to films exported for international release.) *Additional incentives are offered by each city based on job creation and investment.*

Direct Financial Incentives:

- INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT BONDS
The [Department of Business & Industry - <http://www.state.nv.us/b&i/index.htm>](http://www.state.nv.us/b&i/index.htm) issues tax-exempt industrial development bonds to provide low-interest financing for eligible businesses. The interest rate is negotiated between the sponsor and the lender. Cities and counties also issue industrial bonds for manufacturing, industrial warehousing, research and development, and pollution-control facilities. The maximum term is 40 years.
- DIRECT STATE LOANS
The Nevada Revolving Loan Fund program assists Nevada small businesses in obtaining "gap" financing to complete their business expansion projects. Up to \$100,000 is available to Nevada businesses that cannot secure 100% financing from commercial lenders. The rates and terms are tailored to the particular needs of the business, with rates generally below prime and terms amortized up to 15 years.
- TECHNICAL SUPPORT SERVICES
The Procurement Outreach Program provides bid information and direct technical assistance to businesses selling goods and services to the government. The Nevada Small Business Development Center offers advice on operating businesses. The International Trade Program offers assistance to businesses to begin or expand exporting to international markets.
